

CDLT 170-COMPOSITE DRIVING 2 CREDITS

SYLLABUS

CATALOG DESCRIPTION

This one-week course will prepare an experienced Class B operator to upgrade to a Class A license, or to refresh preexisting Class A license skills. The cost of a CDL exam is included in tuition.

Prerequisites: Must be able to pass a Department of Transportation drug screen and obtain a Department of Transportation medical card. Must possess a Class A commercial driver's permit.

- 10. Negotiate corners safely/legally
