

EMSP 242-TRAUMA MANAGEMENT-3 CREDITS


SYLLABUS

CATALOG DESCRIPTION

Theory course covering the pathophysiology, assessment, and management of the trauma patient. Includes discussions on the mechanism of injury, hemorrhage and shock, burns, and injuries to different body systems. Incorporates the Prehospital Trauma Life Support curriculum.

Prerequisites: Admission into the paramedic program
